Why a Sub-I?



Orthopedic surgery is one of the most competitive specialties to apply as a medical student. In Match 2023, 1,425 applicants applied for 899 orthopedic surgery residency spots, resulting in a 63.1% acceptance rate. Sub-I's have emerged as a valuable avenue for medical students to not only delve into the specifics of different programs but also to demonstrate their capabilities through a month-long residency audition. Data supports just how pivotal a Sub-I's role is, with program directors in one study ranking them as the second most influential factor for matching into a program. Nevertheless, many prospective MS4s/OMS4s express a sense of unpreparedness. MSOS's pre-symposium survey of the second annual MSOS symposium revealed that just 33% of students felt adequately prepared to go on their orthopedic Sub-I's. As a result, MSOS set out to establish the Sub-I education summit, aimed at preparing rising M4s for their upcoming away rotations.
